142	<i>Construction Lien Amendment Act</i> – Hon. Y. Naqvi	Improve construction payment rules, including modernizing the lien and holdback process and streamlining dispute resolution.	3 rd Reading
148	<i>Fair Workplaces, Better Jobs Act</i> – Hon. K Flynn	Reform labour laws, including raising the minimum wage to \$15/hr and ensuring part-time workers are paid the same hourly wages as full-timers.	3 rd Reading
154	<i>Cutting Unnecessary Red Tape Act</i> – Hon. B. Duguid	Amend 40 statutes across six ministries to reduce regulatory burdens on businesses.	PASSED
