31	<i>Efficient Local Government Act</i> – Hon. S. Clark	Reduce the size of City of Toronto Council to 25, invoking Section 33 of the Charter to ensure implementation.	DEBATE SUSPENDED
32	<i>Access to Natural Gas Act</i> – Hon. M. McNaughton	Provide rate protection for consumers when gas distributors incur costs for investments to expand access to natural gas.	2 nd Reading
34	<i>Green Energy Repeal Act</i> – Hon. G. Rickford	Repeal the <i>Green Energy Act</i> enacted by the previous Liberal government in 2009.	Social Policy Committee
36	<i>Cannabis Statute Law Amendment Act</i> – Hon. C Mulroney	Create a licensing framework for private retail sales of recreational cannabis; add marijuana to the rules for tobacco smoking.	PASSED
47	<i>Making Ontario Open for Business Act</i> – Hon. J. Wilson	Repeal Liberal labour reforms; Maintain the minimum wage at \$14/hour; wind down the Ontario College of Trades.	1 st Reading
48	<i>Safe and Supportive Classrooms Act</i> – Hon. L. Thompson	Amend legislation around teacher certification, including revoking an educator's licence for any act of sexual abuse of a student or child.	1 st Reading
