4	<i>Cap and Trade Cancellation Act</i> – Hon. R. Phillips	End Ontario’s cap-and-trade program and establish targets for reducing greenhouse gas emissions.	PASSED
31	<i>Efficient Local Government Act</i> – Hon. S. Clark	Reduce the size of City of Toronto Council to 25, invoking Section 33 of the Charter to ensure implementation.	DEBATE SUSPENDED
32	<i>Access to Natural Gas Act</i> – Hon. M. McNaughton	Provide rate protection for consumers when gas distributors incur costs for investments to expand access to natural gas.	3 rd Reading
34	<i>Green Energy Repeal Act</i> – Hon. G. Rickford	Repeal the <i>Green Energy Act</i> enacted by the previous Liberal government in 2009.	3 rd Reading
47	<i>Making Ontario Open for Business Act</i> – Hon. T. Smith	Repeal Liberal labour reforms; Maintain the minimum wage at \$14/hour; wind down the Ontario College of Trades.	PASSED
48	<i>Safe and Supportive Classrooms Act</i> – Hon. L. Thompson	Amend legislation around teacher certification, including revoking an educator's licence for any act of sexual abuse of a student or child.	2 nd Reading
57	<i>Restoring Trust, Transparency and Accountability Act</i> – Hon. V. Fedeli	Omnibus legislation implementing measures in the fall economic statement.	Finance and Econ. Affairs Committee
